Initiative of 'E-Waste Disposal' by R.K. Habitat, Bharuch in Environment sound manner

E-waste was initially dumped into landfills or it was incinerated. The first step taken towards organising e-waste was the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), which was enacted in 1976 by the US government. This act led to the illegal dumping of e-waste in less developed countries. The Basel Convention, 1989 was an international treaty designed to reduce the movement of hazardous waste between nations, and specifically from developed to developing countries. Laws to manage e-waste have been in place in India since 2011, mandating that only authorised dismantlers and recyclers can collect E-waste, which was further reframed in 2016 as E-waste (Management) Rules, 2016 and amended in 2018. Nowadays, for industries disposal of E-waste in Environmental sound manner has become mandatory.

However, E-waste generated from domestic use, is yet unorganised. As a responsible society, Residents of R.K. Habitat have initiated E-waste disposal with support of BEIL Infrastructure Ltd. This Green initiative for E-waste disposal is a feather on the crown of the society, which has also been awarded certificate for being winner in 'Clean Bharuch, Green Bharuch'. It might be the first time in Bharuch that a society has disposed e-waste to an authorised recycler.

The intention of mentioning this article is to create awareness among societies in Bharuch and even outside. We trust people and we are confident that very soon, e-waste will be disposed in an environmental sound manner. Let us take a pledge to serve back to society, Environment and Nation.




