


EHS Forum Meet - 'Learning from Incidents'



VALUE CREATION

These days with cut-throat competitive environment and changes that are taking place around us, value creation is primary objective of any business entity. Creating value for customers while creating value for stakeholders/shareholders have become most important aspect of business.

Value creation is typically misunderstood as strict financial measures of performance, or cost-cutting, which produces short-term results but can damage long term value significantly. If we put value creation first in the right way, it can given enormous advantage in building one's ability to achieve profitable and long-lasting growth to self as well as business.

Understanding the drivers of value creation for respective business and bringing alignment with respective work stream (Operations, Sales & Marketing, Supply Chain, Services, HR...) is the first step.

There can be various value drivers for business, however, for sustainable growth, I would like to share few important value drivers of Operations / Manufacturing units.

- **1. Environment, Health and Safety:** EHS is the heart of value stream as it focuses on eliminating /reducing hazarder incidents, ensures safe workplace, reduce risk to people and asset, complies with environmental regulations, thereby, creates platform for sustainable growth for business.
- **2. Energy :** Energy efficiency brings a variety of benefits: reducing greenhouse gas emissions, and lowering direct costs. While renewable energy technologies also help accomplish these objectives, improving energy efficiency is the cheapest and often the most immediate way to reduce the use of fossil fuels.
- **3.** Waste Control: It helps in reducing non value added work, while utilizing lean manufacturing concept. There are 8 types of waste namely: 1. Defect 2. Over Processing 3. Overproduction 4. Waiting 5. Excess Inventory 6. Transportation 7. Motion Waste 8. Non/Underutilized talent.
- **4. Reliability Maintenance :** It helps to increase cost effectiveness, machine uptime, and minimize risk. RM works on principle of predictive maintenance by operation team unlike routine and reactive maintenance.
- **5. Quality and Efficiency:** First time right product with high output or efficiency have significant impact on material cost reduction.
- **6. Work Culture :** Work culture is foundation for Value creation and sustainable growth of business. It has various elements of working principles such as no bureaucracy, team work, effective delegation, Respect, Humility, entrepreneurship etc.
